- 1. Q. Some of the songs we want are not in your online database. Is there some way you can get them for us? A. Our online database may not be current with what our library actually contains. Please send us an email prodjservice@hotmail.com with a list of the music that you want and we will check it for you. If we still do not have what you want you can supply us with the music, all music must be radio edited. Burn your songs onto a CD in mp3 format and mail the disc to us at, ProDj's PO box 6555 Jackson Mi. 49204 or you can drop it off at our office in the commonwealth commerce center building suite 144 by sliding it under the door then call (517) 581-8939 and let us know it is there so we can get it picked up. We must receive this disc 30 days before your event to give us enough time to review all of the music for content and format it to work with our software
- 2. **Q.** I have music or a slide show ready for you on disks, how do I get them to you? **A.** mail the disc to us at, ProDj's PO box 6555 Jackson Mi. 49204 or you can drop it off at our office in the commonwealth commerce center building suite 144 by sliding it under the door then call (517) 581-8939 and let us know it is there so we can get it picked up.
- 3. **Q.** When will my DJ be contacting me so that I can review everything with him/her? **A.** Your DJ will contact you the week of your event.
- 4. **Q.** I want to change some things on my planning form at the last minute what do I do? **A.** If your event is more than a week away then you can contact Steve, Terry, or Shannon by telephone or email and we may still be able temporarily unlock your planning form, or let us know what changes to make for you. If your event is less than a week away then you will have to wait for your DJ to call you the week of your event and discuss the changes with him/her, the DJ will be limited to the music that we already have in our library at that point.
- 5. **Q.** Can my guests request music before the event? **A.** yes we can set up a guest request list on the website they will be allowed to select 2 songs from our database. This does not guarantee that any particular song will get played.
- 6. **Q.** When Balance Due? **A.** Your balance must be paid in full 2 weeks prior to your event.
- 7. **Q.** How long will Email take to return? **A.** We will make every effort to respond to emails and voicemails within 48 hours.
- 8. **Q.** How much power do you need? **A.** We will need 2, 20 amp, 115 volt circuits No generators or extension cords.
- 9. **Q.** Why can't I use my own generator? **A.** Because we cannot be sure that your generator will supply enough clean power to our equipment to be assured that it will not be destroyed. There are generators that we can connect our equipment to please contact us to discuss this. You will be required to buy an insurance rider that will pay for damaged equipment.
- 10. **Q.** How long will it take for the Dj to set up? **A.** That depends on several factors like, accessibility to the venue, and how many add on items you have. Usually it takes between 1&2 hours.
- 11. **Q.** How much space will the Dj need? **A.** The DJ will require at least a 12 x 6 foot space
- 12. **Q.** How much space will the photo booth need? **A.** The Photo Booth will require at least a 12 x12 foot space
- 13. **Q.** Does my event come with lighting? **A.** Yes even our most basic DJ package comes with state of the art dance floor lighting

- 14. **Q.** When is the deposit due? **A.** We must receive your deposit and signed contract within 15 days of the time we send the contract to you to reserve your date.
- 15. **Q.** Why is my info due 30 days before my event? **A.** This is to give us enough time to prepare for your event, acquire the music, and brief the DJ

- 23. **Q.** When does my time start? **A.** The time that you paid for with your package begins when the DJ begins playing. This is typically when your guests begin to arrive at the venue for cocktail hour.
- 24. Q. Can I choose who will be my Dj? A. You can request a specific person to be your DJ at no additional charge and we will try to honor your request. If however you want to be assured that that person will be your DJ then you can pay a talent fee and we will make sure that that person is assigned to your event unless someone else has paid the fee before you did. In the event of illness or events outside of our control that prevents the DJ from performing then we will supply you with another DJ and refund the talent fee.

If you choose to create your own slideshow then we require that the images be compiled on a DVD that is playable on any home DVD player. If you want audio to accompany the slideshow then the audio tracks must be on a separate CD in CD audio or mp3 format.
